On the heels of H₂Orange₂'s debut, EnviroX, L.L.C. unveiled a hand-held dilution and dispensing system called the Spray Buddy™. With a twist of the wrist, you can choose one of four different dilution options for various cleaning needs.

Other products followed, using the same hydrogen peroxide technology of H₂Orange₂. These include a full line of ready-to-use products, as well as Grout-Safe tile and grout cleaner.

Now, the company breaks another mold with its introduction of H₂Orange₂ Crystal Carpet cleaner. Also based on hydrogen-peroxide technology, the product not only delivers superior cleaning capabilities, but also provides the low re-soiling characteristics of a crystallizing polymer.

Even major carpet manufacturers, such as Mohawk and Mannington, are taking notice of this newest EnviroX innovation by specifically recommending its use in the care and maintenance of their carpets.

The key to H₂Orange₂ is its patented combination of hydrogen peroxide (H₂O₂) and readily biodegradable surfactants and orange oil. These ingredients replace more toxic,

conventional chemical, while improving performance, destroying odors and reducing the total organic residue left on surfaces by as much as 90%.

"Use H₂Orange₂ on virtually any hard surface or fabric ... restrooms, windows, general wipe-down, carpet, tile and VRT floors," adds Stewart. "One product, diluted for various cleaning challenges, does it all. It's used with confidence ... confidence in its safety and in its effectiveness."

H₂Orange₂ is the first and only hydrogen-peroxide modified, multi-purpose product registered by the EPA as a sanitizer-virucide-HIV-stat without a danger or poison warning required.

Used properly, the product is also fungicide and is safe to use on food preparation areas.
