H₂ORANGE₂ AWARDED GREEN SEAL CERTIFICATION

H₂Orange₂™ Concentrate 117, manufactured by Envirox, L.L.C. in Danville, Ill., adds another “first” to its repertoire by becoming the first and only hydrogen peroxide-based multi-purpose cleaner to earn certification under Green Seal’s GS-37 Environmental Standard for Industrial and Institutional Cleaners. Additionally, the company’s Grout-Safe™, a hydrogen peroxide-based tile and grout renovator and heavy-duty cleaner/degreaser, also received Green Seal certification.

In order to obtain Green Seal certification, products must pass a series of rigorous tests to prove conformity to a long list of environmental standards. Green Seal certification provides a third party confirmation of the product’s safety to workers, facilities and the environment.

“We use recognized international criteria in the development of our standards,” points out Mark Petruzzi, vice president of certification for Green Seal.

“Our certification criteria includes many life-cycle aspects of the product and the product’s impact on workers, the facility, building occupants and the environment. Envirox is the third company to have products certified under this standard, and H₂Orange₂ Concentrate 117 and Grout-Safe™ are the first hydrogen peroxide-based products to earn this certification.”



H₂Orange₂ is the first hydrogen peroxide-based cleaning system to be manufactured and marketed in the United States, and the H₂Orange₂ Concentrate 117 is first and only hydrogen peroxide-based product to receive EPA registration as a five-minute sanitizer-virucide-HIV-stat for hard surfaces. H₂Orange₂ is also rated by NSF International as A1, D-2, while Grout-Safe is rated as A-1.

“Green Seal certification adds to the growing list of endorsements for H₂Orange₂,” states Patrick Stewart, president of Envirox, L.L.C. “The product has won the endorsement of many environmentally-concerned entities, as well as those responsible for facility maintenance.” Currently, H₂Orange₂ is an approved Environmentally Preferred Product in the states of Vermont and Massachusetts, the City of Seattle, and is listed by the U.S. Department of the Interior in its green cleaning guidelines.
